Elly has been obsessed with dogs since she was a kid. A former school teacher turned corporate marketing executive for the NBA, NHL, and Radio Disney, Elly has now come full circle by working with a furry muse to redefine her life and career.

Taking inspiration from her real-life pup and her weatherman fiancé, Elly's first book is about a five-pound pup, Schmitty, who goes from daydreaming to doing by overcoming obstacles to learn about the weather to help her two-legged weatherman dad. In the end, Schmitty shows us that no matter what your size or breed, you can do anything you put your mind to.

"Writing a children's book was definitely challenging, but a heck of a lot more fun than going to work in corporate America every day," says Ms McGuire. "Plus, in the State of the Union Address, with the President's call for a nationwide STEM initiative to get kids excited about science, technology, engineering and math, who knew that my *Schmitty The Weather Dog: Daydream* book would bring me back to schools to help make learning about weather and science a fun experience. They will then bring science to kids in New York City before touring schools nationwide.

When not visiting schools, you can also find Elly raising money for pet charities through her line of New Yorkie® products and producing the annual *New Yorkie Runway Celebrity Doggie Fashion Show* during Fashion Week in NYC. Perhaps the only person to have taught a US President to play the spoons, Elly is also the host of #PETCHAT, the popular Monday night show trending on Twitter for the past five years.
